What is a 350W solar panel?

They'll be using solar system "size" to refer to the combined total of each solar panel's wattage or power output. In the UK, a standard 350W residential solar panel is around 1.89m long, 1m wide and 3.99cm thick and contains approximately 60 solar cells.

As they're made up of multiple solar panels (and, as such, generate a lot of power), solar arrays or systems are measured in kilowatts (kW), with  $1\text{kW} = 1,000\text{W}$ . What is a solar panel size?

Refers to the total amount of power a solar panel can generate over a period of time. This is usually calculated by multiplying the panel voltage by the amperage. Solar cell dimensions are typically around 189 x 100 x 3.99cm, while solar panel dimensions are usually between 1.6m<sup>2</sup> to 2m<sup>2</sup>.
