

How do you develop a microgrid control system?

Design a microgrid control network with energy sources such as traditional generation, renewable energy, and energy storage. Model inverter-based resources. Develop microgrid control algorithms and energy management systems. Assess interoperability with a utility grid. Analyze and forecast load to reduce operational uncertainty.
