



Cayman Islands largest battery storage companies

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Wärtilä will deliver the 10MW/10MWh GridSolv Quantum systems under an engineering, procurement, and construction contract, which it said would help CUC almost double its renewable energy capacity on Grand Cayman, the largest of the three Cayman Islands.
