CWP Europe plans to install the Montechevo solar power plant with a total capacity of 400 MW at Lastva, Cevo and Prentin Do on the territory of Montenegro's historic capital Cetinje, in an investment valued at EUR 360 million.

This collaboration signifies a joint commitment to fostering solar and wind development projects in Montenegro while concurrently safeguarding natural and societal values.
