

Do solar panels need Building Regulations approval?

When it comes to solar panels, building regulations approval is crucial. These regulations are in place to ensure that the installation of solar panels is done correctly and safely. They cover various aspects, such as structural integrity, electrical safety, and fire protection.

Do I need a building regulations approval for a PV system?

Building Regulations approval may require the product to have passed the wind uplift, water penetration and spread of flame tests (see section 2.1.1.2). These will usually be applicable only where the PV is integrated into the fabric of the building.

What are the requirements for a PV installation?

Virtually all domestic PV installations will fall under the scope of Part P. Part P requires the relevant Building Control department to be notified and approve the work. There are two routes to comply with the requirements of Part P: Notify the relevant Building Control department before starting the work.

Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?

Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you've earned with your system - so there's absolutely no benefit to installing solar panels that don't meet building regulations. It's crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.

Do I need a building regulations certificate for my solar panel system?

You should receive a building regulations certificate, known as a completion certificate, for your solar panel system. This certificate will assure you and any future owners that the work met all building regulations, which will make it much easier to sell your property at any point.

Do I need planning permission to install a solar PV system?

This amendment classifies the installation of a residential solar PV or solar thermal system as 'permitted development' meaning planning permission is not required before work commences assuming that the installation fulfills the following conditions:
