Do you need planning permission to install solar panels on your roof?

An increasing number of people are investing in solar energy. More and more homes are having solar panels, or solar tiles, installed on their roofs. Of course, with such installations, the topic of planning permission and building regulations often comes to the surface.

Should solar panels be installed on a flat roof?

For this reason, solar panels on flat roofs often require planning permission. What's more, the installation should be planned so it minimises the visual impact on the house and local area, as far as possible. And solar panels should be removed if they're no longer in use. How many solar panels can I install on my roof?

Will homeowners be able to install rooftop solar panels more easily?

Homeowners will be able to install rooftop solar panels more easily without costly planning delays. This was published under the 2022 to 2024 Sunak Conservative government. Homes and businesses will be able to install rooftop solar panels more easily, under new rules announced today.

Can you put solar panels on a building?

Yes, if the installation falls under permitted development. However, if you live in a conservation area or world heritage site you can't put solar panels on the principal or side elevation walls of your house if it fronts a highway. This would require a planning application. Are there restrictions for solar panels on a listed building?

Can a solar panel be installed on a road?

There are a large number of formally approved solar panel installations in conservation areas, including on roofs that face the road. What you need to do is speak to your local council and let them know about your decision to install. Unless there is a valid reason to state otherwise, permission for the installation should be granted.

Can I install solar panels if I don't meet building regulations?

Your local authority can also apply for a Confiscation Order to take away any money you've earned with your system - so there's absolutely no benefit to installing solar panels that don't meet building regulations. It's crucial that your solar installation follows all building regulations.
