How much power does Sierra Leone have?

Sierra Leone's power capacity estimates at 150-MW with approximately 27.5% of the total population and about 4.9% of the rural population currently having access to electricity.

How much does DFC finance a power plant in Sierra Leone?

DFC's approved financing includes a new loan of up to \$292 million to finance the development and upgrade of the power plant's infrastructure and promote electricity reliability and access throughout Sierra Leone.

What does DFC do for Sierra Leone?

"DFC is proud to support the country's first large utility-scale, independent power project and lay the foundation for reliable and affordable electricity in Sierra Leone," said Nisha Biswal, Deputy Chief Executive Officer at DFC.

Project Sierra Leone. In June 2018, Karpowership signed a contract with Sierra Leone's national utility company, Electricity Distribution and Supply Authority (EDSA), the Ministry of Energy (MOE), and the Ministry of Finance (MOF) to deploy a Powership with 30 MW capacity.

FREETOWN, SIERRA LEONE - The U.S. International Development Finance Corporation's (DFC) Deputy CEO (DCEO) Nisha Biswal attended a groundbreaking ceremony today for the Nant Energy project, which is expected to nearly double Sierra Leone's energy capacity and strengthen its ability to draw outside investment.

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DFC has committed to providing financing to support the development of an 83.5 MW combined cycle thermal power plant, which will initially be fueled by liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) before converting to liquefied natural gas (LNG), a cleaner and more energy-efficient fuel.

DFC approved a new loan of up to \$292 million to the Freetown-based Western Area Power Generation



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Project to help develop and upgrade the power plant's infrastructure, promoting reliable access to power throughout Sierra Leone. DFC will also provide up to \$120 million in political risk insurance to crowd-in private investment.

In 2020 Power Leone signed an MOU with the Government of Sierra Leone to construct and operate 40 solar mini-grid sites with 1.4 MW capacity across rural Sierra Leone. In 2024, Sierra Leone is constructing and commissioning 17 of these mini-grid sites (800 kW).
