

## Solar power pot

How does a solar cooking pot work?

Their shape allows for a lot of solar energy to be concentrated onto a single spot: the platform where the cooking pot is placed. This means they're able to heat pots to very high temperatures - up to 200°C in some cases - and can be used for grilling foods or heating water.

What is a panel solar cooker?

The Panel Solar Cooker uses reflective panels to focus sunlight onto a pot. These work best in tropical climates or in the warmer months when wind and heat loss are not an issue. An inexpensive, aluminized cardboard panel cooker can heat food up to 250 degrees Fahrenheit. That is plenty since food starts to cook at 180 degrees F.

Are solar cookers sustainable?

Unlike conventional cookers that use electricity, gas or wood, solar cookers are an ecological and sustainable option, since they do not emit carbon emissions or consume non-renewable resources. Solar cookers work by harnessing the sun's energy to cook food or heat water.

How efficient is a solar cooker?

A solar cooker's efficiency is around 80%. This means that solar cookers do not yet harness 100% of the sun's infrared radiation. Heat transfer through contact (conduction) is an essential part of solar cooking. Heat forces atoms to move faster and generate energy, transferring it to the particles it makes contact with.

What is a box solar cooker?

Box Solar Cookers have an insulated box, topped with a transparent glass or plastic cover and a reflector or reflectors that help heat the box. Temperatures inside the box can reach 400 degrees F and cooking can be done almost unattended, like a slow cooker. This cooker is preferable to a parabolic if small children are around.
