



# Solomon Islands solar fuji

Who supports the Fiji solar project?

IFC has been supported by the governments of Australia and New Zealand through the Fiji Partnership and the Danish Government to carry out this solar project in Fiji.

Why did Fiji install solar panels?

Installed solar panels at the Fiji State House. The Pacific has shown strong support for renewable energy, driven by the need to address climate change and energy security, as well as to mitigate high electricity costs.

Does Fiji have a solar energy system?

Yesterday, an 18.25 kW solar generation system has been launched at the Fiji State House, that will supply the state house with an annual energy production of approximately 20,000 units of electricity. This translates into FJD \$7,400 annual savings on energy cost from a clean energy source.

Why is IFC advising Solomon Islands on the Tina River hydropower project?

As part of its push for the use of more renewable energy sources, IFC has also been advising the government of Solomon Islands on the Tina River Hydropower Development Project, which will see the nation go from almost total reliance on imported diesel to generating the majority of its power needs from renewable energy.
