The Internet country code top-level domain (ccTLD) for South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands is .gs. The parts of the islands that are not permanently covered in snow or ice are part of the Scotia Sea Islands tundra ecoregion.

Who owns South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands?

The United Kingdomclaimed sovereignty over South Georgia in 1775 and the South Sandwich Islands in 1908. The territory of "South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands" was formed in 1985; previously,it had been governed as part of the Falkland Islands Dependencies.

What happened to South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands?

In 1985,South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands ceased to be administered as a Falkland Islands Dependency and became a separate territory. The King Edward Point base,which had become a small military garrison after the Falklands War,returned to civilian use in 2001 and is now operated by the British Antarctic Survey.

Are the South Georgia Islands mountainous?

Most of the islands, rising steeply from the sea, are rugged and mountainous. At higher elevations, the islands are permanently covered with ice and snow. The South Georgia Group lies about 1,390 kilometres (860 mi; 750 nmi) east-southeast of the Falkland Islands, at 54°-55°S,36°-38°W.

With 11 main islands and several smaller islets, the South Sandwich Islands are also part of the South Georgia British Overseas Territory, despite lying around over 700-kilometres southeast. Volcanic in origin, this island chain is incredibly inhospitable and consists of numerous perilous peaks, some of which remain active while others are snow ...

Winter, from June to August, brings extreme conditions to the South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands.With average temperatures oscillating between -2°C (28.4°F) and 2°C (35.6°F), the islands experience intense cold, frequent snowstorms, and strong winds, with speeds reaching up to 40km/h (24.9mph).

South Georgia and the South Sandwich Islands became a British overseas territory in 1985. A commissioner, who is also the governor of the Falkland Islands, oversees the territory. In 1993 Britain extended the territory's exclusive fishing zone from 12 to 200 nautical miles (22 to 370 km). Cruise ships make regular visits to the island.
