Wind turbines convert wind energy to electrical energy for distribution. Conventional horizontal axis turbines can be divided into three components: o The rotor, which is approximately 20% of the wind turbine cost, includes the blades for converting wind energy to low-speed rotational energy.

But for wind speed ($> 25 \text{ m/s}$) it is no longer safe to let the rotor turn - so the blades are set to a neutral position in which they generate no torque and a special electromagnetic brake is engaged to completely ...
