



The best way to clean solar panels is to use a soft-bristled brush or squeegee specifically designed for solar panels, along with a mild soap or specialized cleaning solution. Avoid abrasive materials, excessive pressure, and cleaning during the hottest part of the day. Rinse thoroughly and dry the panels to prevent water spots.

That said, most solar pv panels in the UK will not need any heavy-duty cleaning because regular rain will wash most dirt and grime off the surface, dispelling one of the myths about solar being its difficulty to clean.

Solar maintenance companies like US-based Bland Company and Premier Solar Cleaning have found that using deionized water with a rolling or vehicle-mounted brush allows them to clean panels without using soap, which leaves a residue that not only shades panels but attracts dirt.

Vinegar is a great cleaning agent for solar panels because it contains acetic acid, which is very capable of breaking down tough stains, dirt and grease. It is also readily available and any vinegar will do although the best type to use is white cleaning vinegar.

Cleaning solar panels on a roof requires extra precautions for safety. Use a sturdy ladder or roof anchor system, and wear non-slip shoes. Start by rinsing the panels with a garden hose, then gently scrub with a soft brush and mild soap solution. Rinse thoroughly and dry with a squeegee or cloth. 3. Using a soft brush, remove any loose algae from the solar panel. Gently hose down the panel. In a spray bottle, mix a solution of 1/2 tsp biodegradable soap, 2 cups water and 1/4 cup vinegar. Spray the solution onto the solar panels and rub with a clean cloth or sponge.
